THE PROBLEM.

A key part of America's maritime sector is overlooked. Our 300+ small shipyards build and repair the more than 40,000 military, safety and commercial vessels in the American flag fleet. Yet, increasingly complex vessel design, operating standards and aging facilities make it more challenging for smaller yards to maintain this fleet safely and efficiently.

An investment in America's small shipyards is an investment in the future health, safety and military readiness and of our country. Working with shipyards and industry leaders, the Coalition raises awareness of and advocates for the federal Small Shipyard Grant Program; and safer, greener and more prosperous maritime transportation solutions.


ABOUT THE COALITION

MARAD'S SMALL SHIPYARD GRANT PROGRAM

- Funds both coastal & inland waterways facilities
- \$95m since the Coalition was created, \$262m total
- ARRA awarded the most funding at \$100m
- Program is oversubscribed 10x on average

SMALL SHIPYARD GRANT COALITION 117TH CONGRESS POLICY POSITIONS:

- Recommit to supporting the Small Shipyard Grant Program by authorizing \$40m annually
- Invest in America's Small Shipyards by fully funding the Small Shipyard Grant Program authorization
- Leverage the economic and environmental benefits of marine transportation by funding the Small Shipyard Grant Program at \$100m in any future infrastructure or stimulus legislation
